Chateau Pavie is the largest Saint Emilion Premier Grand Cru Classe in Bordeaux. In 2012, Chateau Pavie was promoted to Premier Grand Cru Classes (A) from Classes (B). Typically, Pavie is a blend of 55% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. **Les Aromes de Pavie** is the second wine of Chateau Pavie. It possesses some of the great character of Chateau Pavie.

Monbousquet is a blend of 60% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Franc and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon. Robert Parker has declared: "Chateau Monbousquet under Gerard Perse's guidance is exceptional. Right now this growth is probably the most exotic and most sensual wine in Saint Emilion, if not in all of Bordeaux."

Pavie Decesse is also owned by Mr. Gérard Perse (owner of Pavie). The vineyards of Chateau Pavie Decesse are situated on the St. Emilion limestone plateau. The soils have deposits of clay and limestone. It is dominated by Merlot (90%) with some Cabernet Franc (10%). This estate has old vines with age more than 40 years. Pavie Decesse is rich, with soft textures and chalk-like minerality.

Clos Les Lunelles is acquired by Mr. Gérard Perse (owner of Pavie) in 2001. It is one of the top Bordeaux wines of the Cotes de Castillon appellation. The Clos Lunelles 8.5 hectare vineyard is planted on the clay and limestone plateau. The wine is dominated by Merlot (80%) with Cabernet Sauvignon (10%) and Cabernet Franc (10%). The old vines of this estate are over 45 years.
