## Highland Park Old & Rare Single Cask 1996 18 Yrs (51.7% Vol.)

By the legendary Magnus Eunson, preacher by day illicit distiller by night. One of the most remote distilleries in the world its location gives access to unique heather peat from its own moor, water from a spring that has fed it for over 200 years. A cool maritime climate allows the spirit to interact gently with oak casks developing a fabulously rich, layered whisky lauded by connoisseurs.

*Colour: Glowing amber*

*Nose: Honey, vanilla and marzipan*

*Palate: Delicately sweet, slightly peppery initially with vanilla caramel butter shortbread richness, dark chocolate*

*Finish: long and drying with oak and smoke*

## Glenlivet Old Particular 1997 18 Yrs (48.4% Vol)

1823 Excise Act created, George Smith first distiller in Highlands to obtain license to distil. Est.1824 The Glenlivet. Neighbouring distilleries were illegally run and smuggling was rife. They became indignant, for George Smith was running Glenlivet by legal means. Such was the tempest of their fury, George had to carry a pair of pistols for protection.

- Nose: Clear tangerine citrus fruit, sizzling Crêpe Suzette spiciness and jelly candies
- Palate: An attractively honeyed element swirling around strawberries & cream candy and fresh ginger bread
- Finish: A long sultry finish of dry orange curaçao, dried orange peel.
- Production: 108 btl

## Glenlivet Silver Seal 1979 35 Yrs "Whisky is Art" Series (51.3% Vol)

Glenlivet a name which at that time represented a favored area for the quality of its whiskey. George Smith, an illegal distiller in Speyside went legit when he obtained the first license to legally distill whisky in 1824. A brave act to some to other high treason, allowed him to take a step ahead of her colleagues.

- Nose: A memory of walking through lush forest after a summer rain jump out
- Palate: Deliciously delicate apples, almond oil, light honey, blond tobacco, fresh walnuts, sunflowers, antique leather, porcini mushroom aromas  
appearance pleasant surprising
- Finish: Amalfi lemon crystallised citrus, peppermint creams, soft spongecake spices, luscious herbaceous note give a softly drying finish
