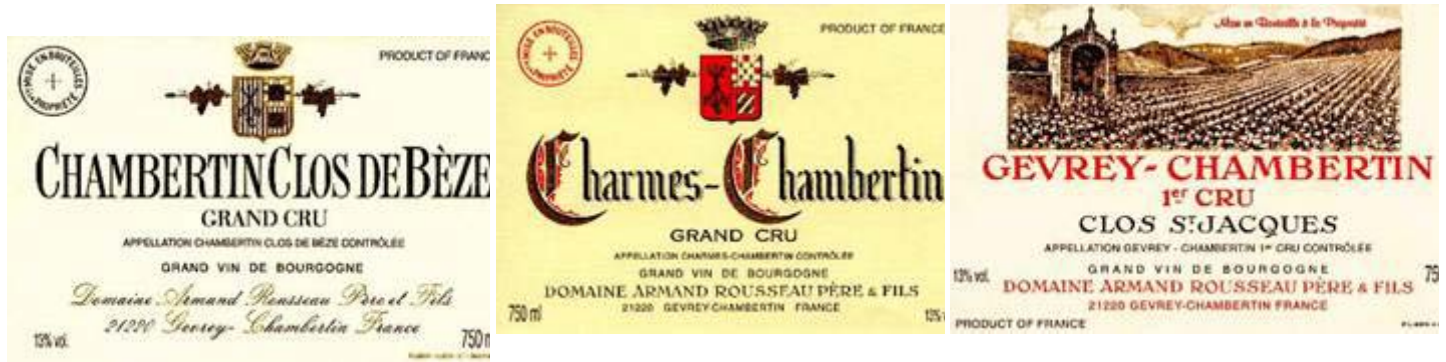

Dear Armand Rousseau Wine Fans,

Kung Xi Fat Choi!!! Starting the year of Goat with the crème de la crème from Burgundy – ARMAND ROUSSEAU. For a burgundy wine lover, this is a wine you must have in your cellar! All first come first serve. For wines quoted in UK GBP (£), you can decide to settle in GBP or in HK\$, daily spot exchange rate will apply. Please expect approximately 10 workings days for the wine to arrive HK after payment in full. Photos can be requested upon request.



Armand Rousseau Chambertin Clos de Beze 2012 -- \$64,800 for cs of 6 (\$10,800/btl) – Original Carton immediate stock in HK – Lowest in HK!!

Allen Meadow (Burghound) 97 points (tasted on Jan 15, 2015): “A highly spiced and exceptionally fresh, ripe and airy nose mixes a wide variety of mostly red berry fruit aromas though there are background notes of plum, cassis, lavender and oak. The broad-shouldered flavors possess a seductive texture thanks to the copious amounts of dry extract that push the very firm tannic spine to the background. I very much like the concentration here as well as the vibrancy and this is very, very dry in the best sense of the term, indeed it is presently almost crisp yet the very dense supporting tannins are clearly quite ripe. This should be a fantastic Bèze in time and eventually the 2012 could rank among the great vintages for this storied wine.”

Armand Rousseau Clos de la Roche 2012 -- \$13,920 for cs of 6 (\$2,320/btl) – Original Carton immediate stock in HK – Lowest in HK!!

Allen Meadow (Burghound) 91-94 points (tasted on Jan 15, 2014 barrel tasting): “A broad-ranging nose features aromas of humus, violet, plum, dark raspberry and again plenty of earth influence. This is also tautly muscular with plenty of size, weight and power yet the mouth feel is, at least at present, still relatively tender and caressing, all wrapped in a palate coating, long and balanced finish. There is excellent phenolic maturity to the supporting structural elements and this should amply repay 12 to 15 years of cellaring.”

Armand Rousseau Charmes Chambertin 2010 -- £560 for pack of 3 (≈ HK\$2,294/btl based on 12.15 exchange rate, logistics included) – Offered in London bonded warehouse not in original carton

Allen Meadow (Burghound) 91-93 points (tasted on Jan 10, 2012): “This is much more deeply pitched than usual with notes of earth and violets and while there are traces of red berry aromas, this hails more from the dark berry side of the fruit spectrum. There is excellent volume to the very rich and round middle weight plus flavors that possess a velvety mouth feel on the focused and impressively long finish. This also exhibits more depth of material than it usually does and this is one of the better Rousseau Charmes of recent years.”

Armand Rousseau Ruchottes Chambertin 2005 -- £1,650 for cs of 6 (2 cs available) (≈ HK\$3,368/btl based on 12.15 exchange rate, logistics included) – Original Carton in London bonded warehouse

Allen Meadow (Burghound) 94 points (tasted on Jan 01, 2008): “A more deeply pitched and very cool nose offers up very ripe dark berry fruit, truffles, spice hints and a touch of the sauvage, the latter of which can also be found on the rich, full and sweet medium weight plus flavors that deliver fine punch and precision on the delineated and exceptionally pure mineral infused finish. While always a fine wine in the Rousseau stable, 2005 is one of the best vintages that I have seen and it will age well.”

Armand Rousseau Clos de la Roche 2005 -- £1,600 for cs of 6 (2 cs available) (≈ HK\$3,266/btl based on 12.15 exchange rate, logistics included) – Original Carton in London bonded warehouse

Allen Meadow (Burghound) 91-93 points (tasted on Jan 01, 2007): “A more elegant and slightly more complex nose of red berry and blue fruit aromas nuanced with an array of subtle hints of game, spice, earth and underbrush leads to rich, intense and even more detailed flavors that culminate in a linear and driving finish that offers impressive punch and energy. Like the Mazis, there is a sleek muscularity here and a real sense of underlying tension on the explosive finish.”

Armand Rousseau Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Clos St Jacques 1997 -- £1,600 for cs of 6 (≈ HK\$3,266/btl based on 12.15 exchange rate, logistics included) – Original Carton in London bonded warehouse

Allen Meadow (Burghound) 91 points (tasted on Jul 01, 2004): “Simply stunning nose of Gevrey earth, complex red fruits and a certain unmistakable breed followed by rich, full, only moderately ripe flavors and a tight, intense, very persistent finish. This is a very pretty wine and is somewhat atypical of the vintage as it possesses both good acidity and avoids over ripeness. A first class success for the vintage.”

Armand Rousseau Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Clos St Jacques 2010 -- £1275 for pack of 3 (≈ HK\$5,190/btl based on 12.15 exchange rate, logistics included) – Offered in London bonded warehouse not in original carton

Allen Meadow (Burghound) 91-94 points (tasted on Jan 14, 2013): “Discreet and well-integrated wood frames wonderfully fresh, airy, refined and beautifully complex aromas of red currant, warm earth, stone, crushed herbs and spice hints. The excellent depth of the nose continues onto the equally cool and brilliantly refined mineral-inflected medium-bodied flavors that possess outstanding depth of material and simply stunning length. While there have been many great vintages of Clos St. Jacques since 1955, it's at least possible the 2010 version could match some of the very best of them. I stress however that lots of patience will be required because even though the nose is presently still expressive, even after a few minutes in the glass this appears to be already shutting down.”
